As announced in <u>Budget 2024</u>, the scholarship and fellowship programs administered by the three federal research funding agencies – the <u>Canadian Institutes of Health Research</u> (CIHR), the <u>Natural Sciences and Engineering</u> <u>Research Council</u> (NSERC), and the <u>Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council</u> (SSHRC) – have been streamlined into a new harmonized talent program called the **Canada Research Training Awards Suite (CRTAS)** that will open for applications in summer 2025.

The annual number of scholarships and fellowships available to graduate students and postdoctoral researchers will increase by 1,720 awards.

- 300 at the master's level
- 1,200 at the doctoral level
- 220 at the postdoctoral level



Canada Graduate Research Scholarship – Master's (CGRS M)

Duration: 1 year Value: \$27,000

Selection criteria:

- Academic excellence (50%);
- Research potential (30%);
- Personal characteristics and interpersonal skills (20%).

Eligibility:


- Must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident of Canada, or a Protected Person
- Either enrolled in an eligible master's or direct-entry doctoral program with a significant research component, or have applied for, or are intending to apply for, an eligible program.
- The award may only be held at eligible Canadian post-secondary institutions.
- Not have held or be currently holding a Master's level scholarship from CIHR, NSERC or SSHRC

The master's-level Indigenous Scholars Awards and Supplements program currently offered by NSERC and SSHRC will be extended to CIHR for the 2025/2026 competition cycle.





Canada Graduate Research Scholarship – Master's (CGRS M)



Up-to-date **official transcripts** of all undergraduate and graduate studies must be included in the application, including transcripts for the fall term of the year of application, whether they contain grades or not.

Canada Graduate Research Scholarship - Doctoral (CGRS D)





Duration: **3 years** Value: **\$40,000**

Selection criteria:

- Research Potential (50%);
- Relevant experience and achievements obtained within and beyond academia (50%).

Eligibility:

- Must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident of Canada, Protected Person, or foreign citizen.
- Either enrolled in an eligible doctoral program with a significant research component or have applied for, or are intending to apply for, an eligible program.
- Foreign citizens must be enrolled in a doctoral program of study at an eligible Canadian institution at the time of application.
- Up to 15% of all doctoral awards will be awarded to international applicants.
- The award may be held at both Canadian and international post-secondary institutions.
- Approximately 20% of all doctoral awards would be eligible to be held abroad.
- International applicants may only hold the award in Canada.
- The doctoral program will maintain the practice of setting institutional quotas.





- Eligibility for CGRS D is based on the number of months of full-time study, including summer months, you completed by **December 31 of the calendar year** of your application toward the degree for which you are requesting funding.
- All applicants must be in term 9 or less of their doctoral program (increased from term 6 or less)
 by Fall 2025
- You can submit a maximum of **one scholarship** or fellowship application per academic year to either CIHR, NSERC or SSHRC. If you submit more than one application, only the eligible application submitted first will be retained.
- You can apply a maximum of three times to this funding opportunity.
- You cannot have already received a doctoral-level scholarship from CIHR, NSERC or SSHRC.
- You **cannot** hold a tenure or tenure-track appointment or be on leave from such an appointment concurrently with your CGRS D award.
- Joint programs with a professional degree (for example, MD/PhD, DVM/PhD, JD/PhD, MBA/PhD), as well as clinically oriented programs of study, including clinical psychology, are eligible if they have a significant autonomous research component





If you are eligible to apply directly to one of the agencies, you must submit your application using the appropriate agency application portal before 8:00 pm (ET) on October 17.

• NSERC: **71** (-8)

Canada Postdoctoral Research Award (CPRA)

Duration: 2 year Value: \$70,000

Selection criteria:

- Research potential and experience (50%)
- Quality of proposed research program (50%)

Eligibility:

- Must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident of Canada, Protected Persons, or a foreign citizen, and either hold a doctorate or be enrolled in the final year of their doctoral program.
- Up to 20% of all postdoctoral awards will be awarded to international applicants.
- The award may be held at both Canadian and international post-secondary institutions.
- Approximately 30% of all postdoctoral awards would be eligible to be held abroad.
- International applicants may only hold the award in Canada.
- Applicants may apply a maximum of **three times** to this funding opportunity.
- You can submit a maximum of one scholarship or fellowship application per academic year to either CIHR, NSERC or SSHRC.
- You cannot hold a CPRA concurrently with another tri-agency research training award.

Canada Graduate Scholarships - Michael Smith Foreign Study Supplements

Duration: 2-6 months

Value: **\$6,000**

Eligibility:

- The Canada Graduate Scholarships Michael Smith Foreign Study Supplements (CGS-MSFSS) are available to Canadian citizens, permanent residents of Canada or Protected Persons under subsection 95(2) of the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act (Canada).
- Must be registered in a graduate research studies program at a Canadian institution for the duration of your research study period abroad
- Must have accepted or currently hold a CGS (master's or doctoral) or be eligible Vanier CGS
- Undertake your proposed trip abroad no earlier than the competition deadline date
- Not hold, or have held, any other CGS-MSFSS during the course of your graduate studies

Ontario Graduate Scholarships (OGS) and QEII Graduate Scholarships in Science and Technology

Duration: 1 year Value: \$15,000

Eligibility:

- Be a Canadian citizen, a Permanent Resident, a Protected Person [under subsection 95 (2) of the Immigration and Refugee Protections Act (Canada)], or an International student who holds a valid study permit.
- Be a current graduate student in (or an applicant to) an approved Western graduate program.
- Have a minimum of three terms remaining in their funding-eligible period as of the award start date.
- Have a Social Insurance Number in the Student Center.
- Have cleared any OSAP restriction, placed on their account by the Student Financial Assistance Branch and/or the Canada Student Financial Assistance Program, before taking up the OGS/QEII-GSST.

Students are required to submit one application to be considered for both Tri-agencies and OGS/QEII awards.

Western has an allocation of 8 OGS to offer to international students. Western has an allocation of 2 OGS to offer to Indigenous students.

- Strengthens your CV Demonstrates initiative and academic excellence
- Builds your scholarly reputation Recognized awards show credibility and impact
- Advances your career Supports your development as a highly qualified researcher


How to Prepare a Strong Application

- Start Early Give yourself enough time for drafting, feedback, and revisions
- Review the Guidelines Carefully Understand the eligibility, criteria, and deadlines
- Talk to Your Supervisor Get feedback and alignment with your research goals
- Reach Out to Referees Early Give your referees time and the materials they need
- Write a Clear and Compelling Proposal Focus on clarity, significance, and feasibility
- Ask for Feedback Have your proposal reviewed by peers or mentors
- Gather All Required Documents Transcripts, CV, research proposal, reference letters, etc.
- Submit Your Application On Time Double-check submission details and confirmations
